Furthermore, he broke the Youth National Record for a 3-game series, rolling a 756 to beat his own record by 3 pins.

COMPOSITE AVERAGE

MTBA MEMORIAL 2020 IN HONOUR OF SILVIO ANASTASI AND SAMMY BORG

This tournament saw its inception last year, and its popularity continued in 2020, when the tournament was fully booked once again. In fact, we had the max number of 35 participants – 12 females, and 23 males. In the female category Sue Abela led effortlessly, only faltering in the last game but still winning this tournament by 45 pins and was the only female to roll a 200+ scratch series (1202). 2nd place was won by Cynthia Frenedo Duca with a 1157. The tussle for 3rd place was between Tiziana Carannante and Liliana Spiteri, both rolling a 1131, but Liliana managed to nip the 3rd place as her 6th game was higher than Tiziana's.



The male competition was intense with Matthew Magro leading all the way. At his heels were another 6 players, but Matthew persevered to emerge as the winner with a 1307 series, and the only 1300+ series of the tournament. Hot on heels were 5 contenders: Nicholas Muscat, Mark Spiteri, Mauro Anastasi, Neil Sullivan and Rankin Camilleri who were all within reach of the top 3 places. Young Muscat surged through with a 200 game to win 2nd place with a 1298 series, whereas senior Mark Spiteri nipped the 3rd place with a 1282 total
