

## MBA NEWSLETTER May 2023

#### Hello all!

So first of all a big apology for being so late with the MAY newsletter which you will likely be reading not before the 7<sup>th</sup> of June. Hopefully by end of June my schedule will be a bit easier so this will not happen again (or so I hope...). So let's roll it off for this month.

Bowling in May was easily dominated by the Mediterranean Bowling Championships in San Marino where our team composed of Sue Abela, Cynthia Frendo Duca, Mauro Anastasi and Kayden Lagana' brought home a great collection of medals with some really awesome bowling. You all know the results and have seen numerous posts and articles so I will not go into a lot of detail here.. However, we need to at least summarise as it was a very successful championship for Team Malta!

#### Total Medal Haul..6!!! 1 Gold, 2 silver and 3 bronze!!!

GOLD: Sue Abela (Women all events), the undisputed Queen of the Med in bowling. Sue won her 37<sup>th</sup> career Mediterranean medal by scoring a strong 195.9 average after all the 24 games, just under 100 pins ahead of second placed Alija Bergauer, of Slovenia and Alexandra Lopes of France on 4606.

SILVER : Sue Abela & Cynthia Frendo Duca (Women's doubles), Kayden Lagana' (Men's masters)

BRONZE: Kayden and Mauro (Men's doubles), Kayden and Sue (Mixed doubles), and team event with Cynthia, Sue, Kayden and Mauro.

We cannot fail to mention the simply outstanding performance by 15 year old Kayden. On his way to winning silver, Kayden shot a 246 followed by a 300 to establish a new MBC record of 546, and put himself in the Championship Record Books. Kayden, while missing out on gold by a mere 2 pins to France's Gregory Ruis (494-492), still became the youngest male medallist in MBC History after the bronze in the med's doubles aged 15 years and 177 days.



The team scored a combined total of 4851 pins that ensured a comfortable 3<sup>rd</sup> place ahead of Team Slovenia, with Gold going to France (5071) and silver to Turkey (4898).



Overall, Kayden finished 5<sup>th</sup> in the all events with a remarkable 5138 total (221.6 average) and Mauro finished 14<sup>th</sup> out of 30 contestants, rolling a 4891 (203.8 average). In the ladies, with Sue coming first and winning gold with a 195.9 average over the 24 games, Cynthia finished in 10<sup>th</sup> with a 4420 total and 184.2 average ( out of 30 contestants)

Thank you Sue, Cynthia, Mauro and Kayden for making the MBC 2023 a memorable one for Maltese bowling.



## **Spring Tournament**

We also had the MBA Spring tournament towards the end of May . a 6 game total event, with HC, and separate male and female categories. This event was fully booked at 35 bowlers and saw youth bowlers dominating the male category, with Nicholas Muscat rolling a 1351 (221.8) series ahead of Miguel Xuereb (1315) and Nicolai Mallia (1311), all 3 with no handicap. The ladies section saw Melissa Swift bowl a 1290 (1224 scratch + 66 HC), to finish ahead of Tiziana Carannante 1253 (1205+48 HC) and Sue Abela 1224 (1224 + 0 HC).





### Leagues

The Premier League is now close to its end and , while it was not over at the end of May, Team BOOM are now crowned worthy champions. They were made to wait another week as Team Brunswick inflicted the first defeat of the season on team Boom in week 15 of 18. We will celebrate Team Boom's achievement in the June edition at the end of the week.. but we still Congratulate them already now!!!
