Youth top bowlers under 21 years of age are: Matthew Magro (191.02), Edward Xuereb (185.40) and Kurt Attard (178.11). Sara Xuereb (189.92), Alessia Schembri (180.80) and Raquel Xuereb (174.03) are the best U21 females.

ROME OPEN

6 of our bowlers went to compete in the Rome Open: Mauro Anastasi, Neil Sullivan, Mark Muscat, Daniel Grech, Jonathan Sciberras and Sammy Borg.

After playing during various squads, the best 6 games scoring was from Mauro who managed a 1244 to finish in 13th place. Next was Neil Sullivan who finished in 36th place with a 1179, Mark Muscat 63rd (1147), Sammy Borg position 120 (1063), Daniel Grech with a 1045 in 144th place, and Jonathan Sciberras in 273rd place (926). This was from a total of 313 bowlers.

As I mentioned before Mauro had rolled a 1244 to win Squad 11, which placed him in 13th place and won him an immediate place in step 3. Rolling a 537 he finished in 13th place from this step, and in 21st position from a total of 313 bowlers. Well done Mauro.



SWISS TEAM EVENT

2 of our bowlers namely Sue Abela and Matthew Magro went to participate in the Swiss Team Event which was held at Bowling Miami, Switzerland. Together with Tanya Cuva and Damir Brazenac they formed team Gravity. The competition was based on 2 days, and the team succeeded in placing 7th from 16 teams.



Individually they played the following averages over 15 games: Sue Abela (181.08 + 8 handicap) and Matthew Magro (184.40).



LUTON – YTE

9 of our Youth bowlers went to participate in the Luton YTE. Bowlers were, Edward, Sara and Miguel Xuereb, Kurt Attard, Matthew Magro, Dwayne Zahra, Kayden Lagana and Chris and Kathryn Fenech.

Kayden, Kathryn and Chris participated in group A with Kayden finishing in 7th place, Chris in 9th place and Kathryn in 10th place from a total of 14 bowlers.

Edward and Dwayne participated in group B. Edward rolled a 1162 to place 3rd in this category whilst Dwayne bowled a 1023 to finish in 15th place from a total of 24 players.

However Dwayne succeeded in making it through to next round by rolling a good 218 in the Desperado.

Sara, Matthew, Kurt and Miguel participated in Group C. Sara succeeded in placing 7th with a 1151 scratch series. Miguel placed 27th, Kurt 29th and Matthew 32nd from a total of 33 bowlers.

Sara, Edward and Dwayne then moved on to the next round.

Sara faced England's Ki Leighfield and lost 2-1 in group C. Edward and Dwayne were in group B with the former losing 2-1 to Vedran Delandhuy of the Netherlands. Dwayne on the other hand impressed with a 188 – 204 – 239 and beat England's Dan Harding 2-1 to proceed to the next stage.

He then faced Ireland's Taylor Williams and lost 2-0 to place in 3rd place in group B, which was for the U17 category. Very good placing for the 13 year old.

Kathryn Fenech was honoured with an encouragement award plus a Brunswick ball.



9th SENIOR NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS – SPONSORED BY BANK OF VALLETTA

The tournament ended on 1st October, which is why newsletter is a day late. This year, the championships, which were sponsored by Bank of Valletta, attracted 12 seniors, 4 ladies and 8 males, all vying to be crowned this year's National Senior Champion and win a free entry to the Seniors' Open which will be held later this week.



In the ladies section Sue Abela literally had no competition at all from the other ladies. On day 1 she led by over 336 pins, and by day 2 she won the title by a massive 555 pins rolling a good 2625 series. Marthese Cossai placed 2nd, whilst Liliana Spiteri came 3rd.

The men's category is usually much keener, as competition is steeper. Day 1 saw Mark Spiteri lead with a 1405 series, with Paul Gray close at heel (1401) and Dennis Mercieca lagging behind with a 1298.

Whilst Mark continued to bowl constant games on the second day for another good 1384 series, he easily clinched the title by 146 pins with a total of 2789 to break the Senior record on a 12 game series (2753 scratch). Paul Gray dropped to a 1242 series, but managed to hang on to 2nd place for a total of 2643, whilst Dennis Mercieca rolled a total of 2583 to settle for 3rd place.
